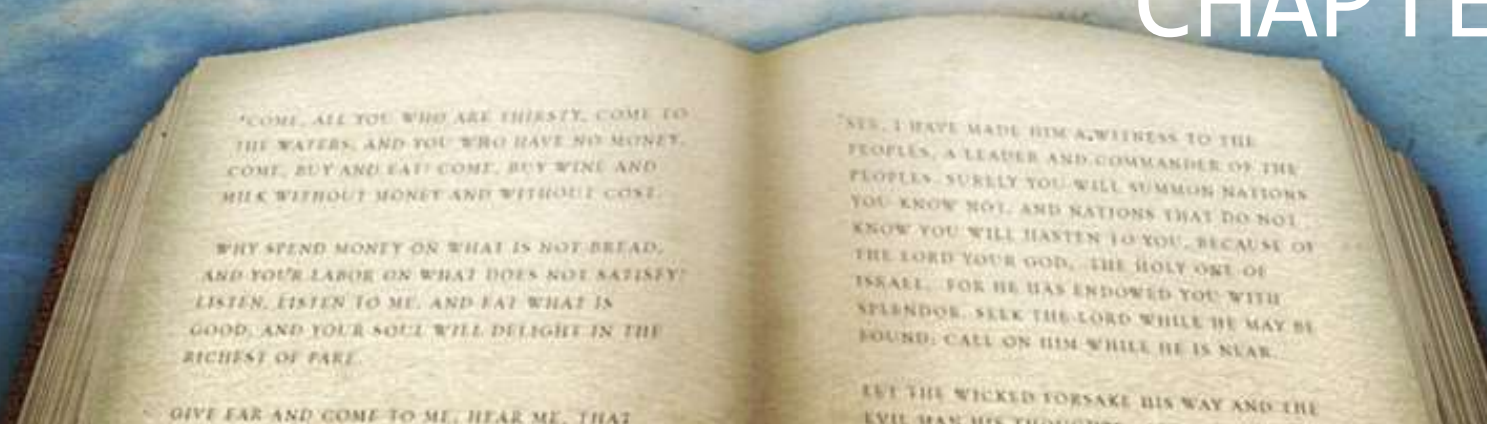

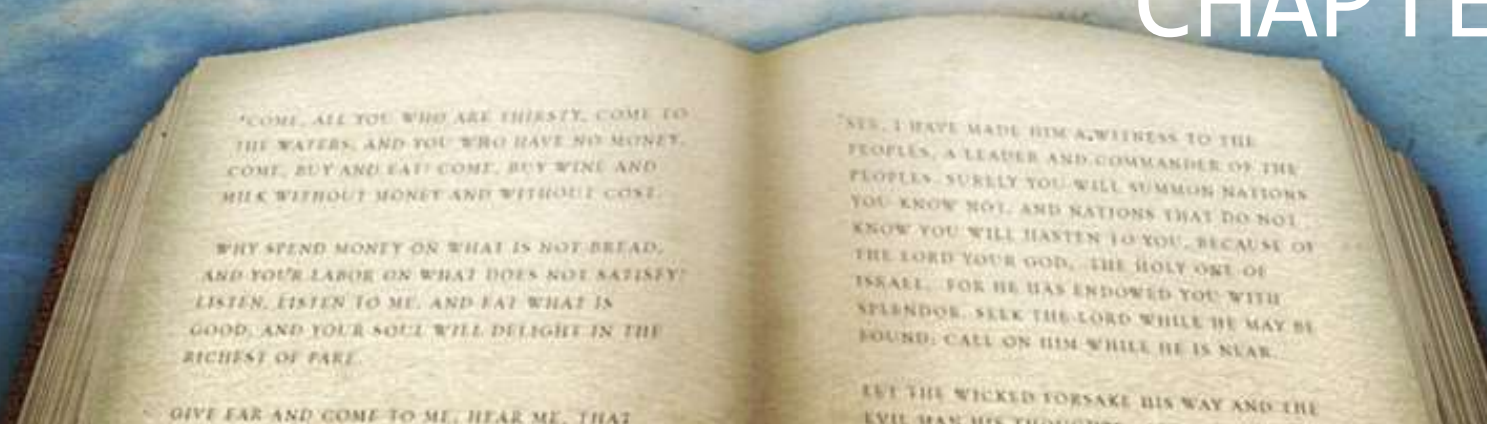

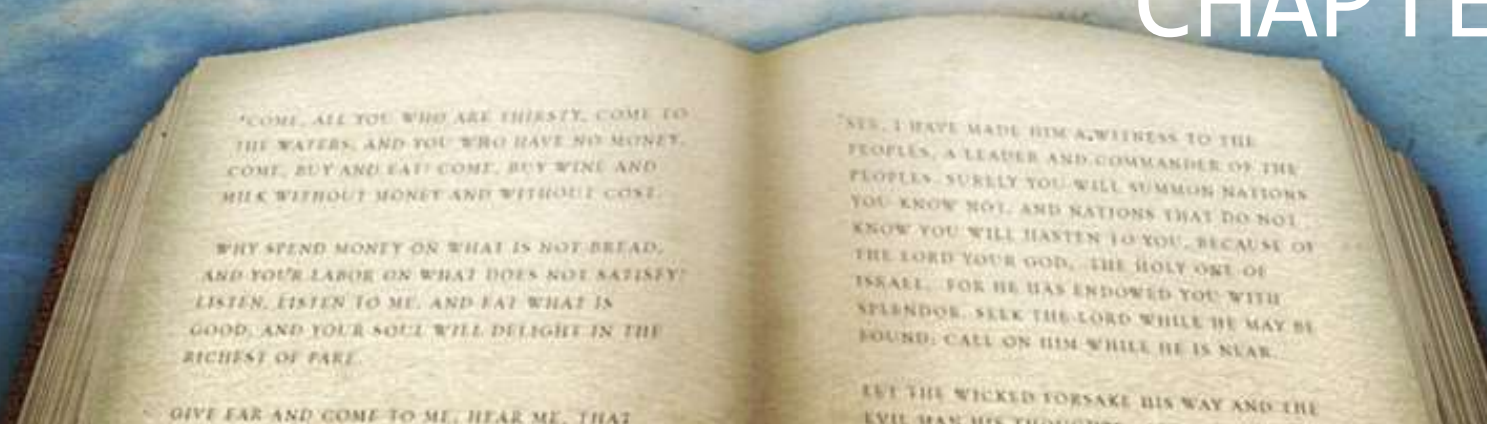

carnal?

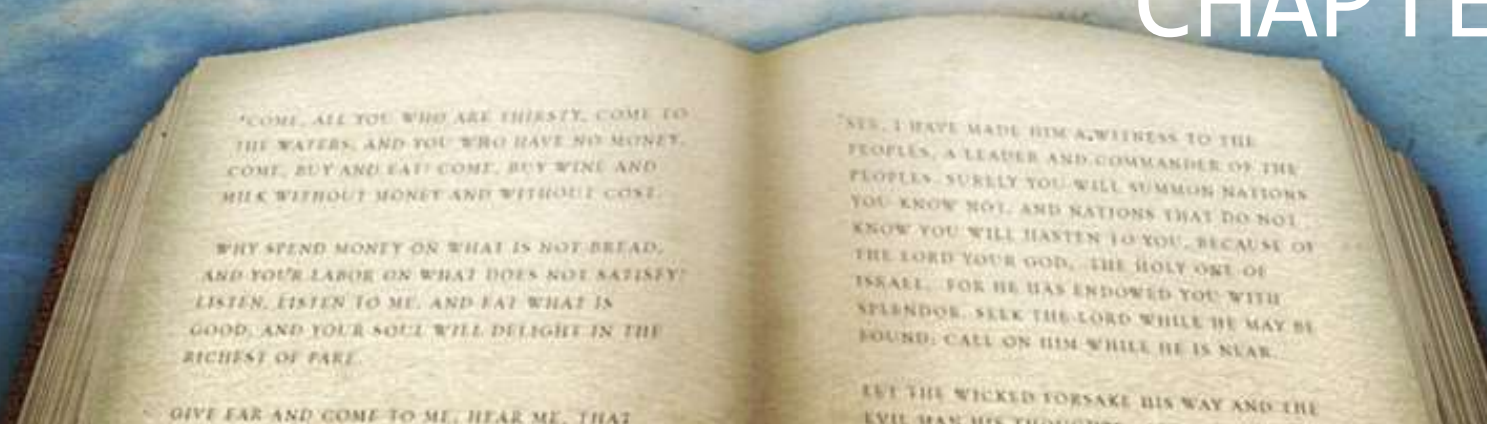

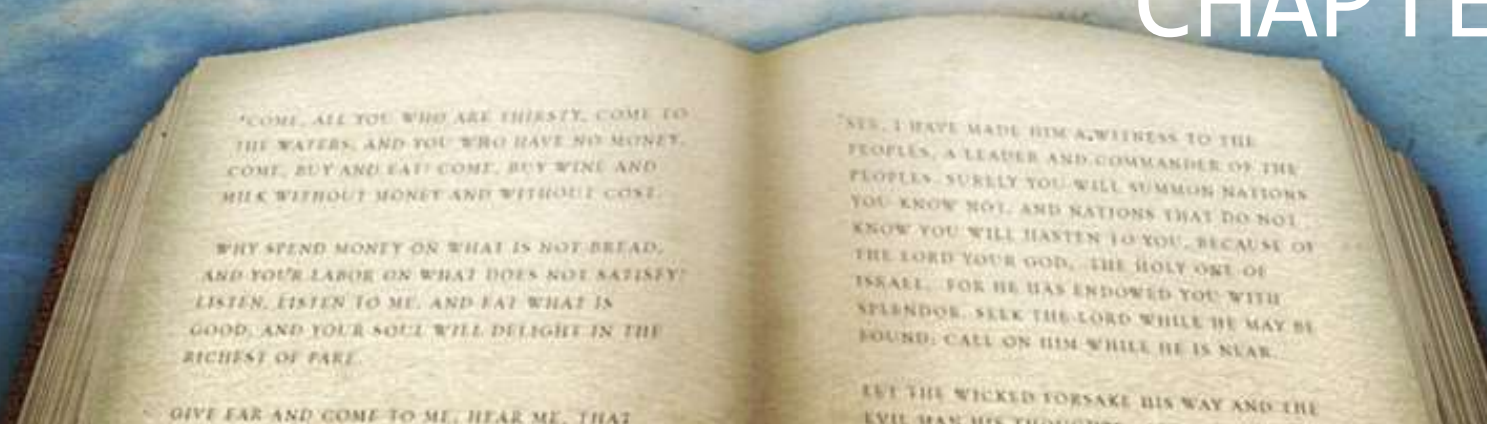

At some point, every true disciple must make an honest evaluation of his / her life **AND** their motivation for following Christ

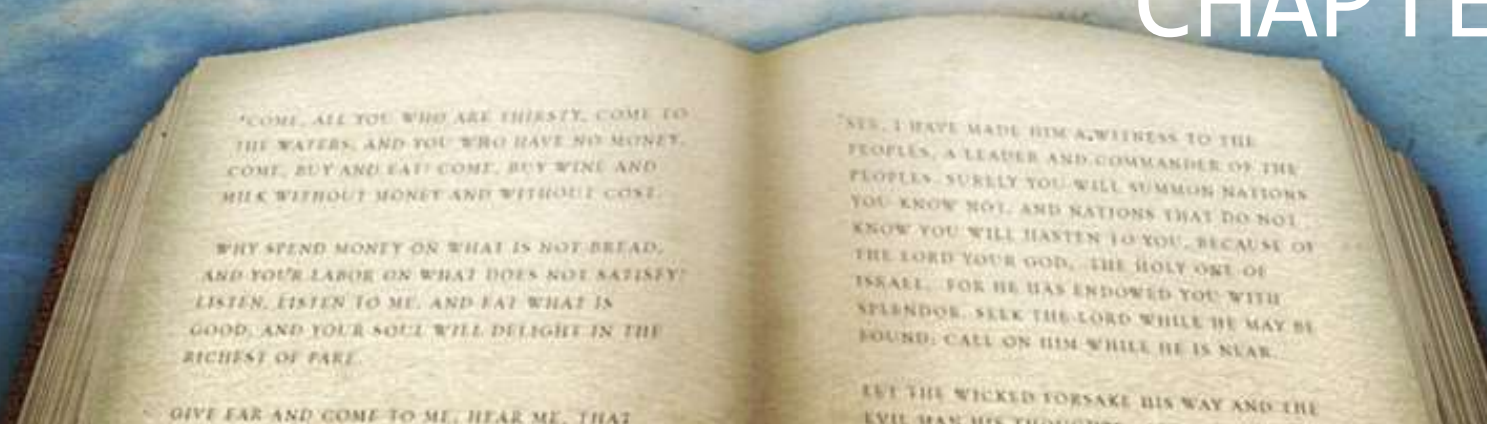
